

## Sanctify- Sanctification.

Sanctify: Greek- Hagiazo=to make holy, purify or consecrate; (mentally) to venerate:- hallow, be holy, sanctify.

Mat-23: 16-22	K/V- 17.	Fools and blind! For which is greater, <b>the gold or the temple that sanctifies the gold?</b> (1-Cor-3:16-17.)
John-10: 33-38	K/V- 36.	-do you say of Him whom the <b>Father sanctified and sent into the world</b> , 'You are blaspheming,' because I said, 'I am the Son of God'?
John-17: 14-26	K/V- 17.	<b>Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth.</b> (Titus-3:5.)
Acts-20: 28-32	K/V- 32.	So now, brethren, I commend you to God and to the word of His grace, <b>which is able to build you up and give you an inheritance among all those who are sanctified.</b>
Acts-26: 17-18	K/V- 18.	-to open their eyes, in order to turn them from darkness to light, <b>and from the power of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who are sanctified by faith in Me.'</b> (John-15:3.)
Rom-15: 15-21	K/V- 16.	-that I might be a minister of Jesus Christ to the Gentiles, ministering the gospel of God, that the offering of the Gentiles might be acceptable, <b>sanctified by the Holy Spirit.</b>
1-Cor-1: 2-3	K/V- 2.	To the church of God which is at Corinth, <b>to those who are sanctified in Christ Jesus</b> , called to be saints, with all who in every place call on the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours:
1-Cor-1: 27-31	K/V- 30.	But of Him you are in Christ Jesus, who became for us wisdom from God--and <b>righteousness and sanctification and redemption--</b>
1-Cor-6: 9-12	K/V- 11.	And such were some of you. But you were washed, <b>but you were sanctified</b> , but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God. (Eph-5:26.)
1-Cor-7: 10-16	K/V- 14.	For the unbelieving husband is sanctified by the wife, <b>and the unbelieving wife is sanctified by the husband</b> ; otherwise your children would be unclean, but now they are holy.
Eph-5: 24-27	K/V- 26.	<b>-that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word,</b>
1-Thes-4: 1-4	K/V- 4.	-that each of you should <b>know how to possess his own vessel in sanctification and honor,</b>
1-Thes-5: 1-4	K/V- 23.	<b>Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely</b> ; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.
2-Thes-2: 13-14	K/V- 13.	But we are bound to give thanks to God always for you, brethren beloved by the Lord, <b>because God from the beginning chose you for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and belief in the truth,</b> (Jn-14:6.) (Jn-15:3.) (Titus-3:5.)
1-Tim-4: 1-5	K/V- 4. K/V- 5.	<sup>4</sup> . For every creature of God is good, and nothing is to be refused if it is received with thanksgiving; <sup>5</sup> <b>for it is sanctified by the word of God and prayer.</b>
2-Tim-2: 18-22	K/V- 21.	<b>Therefore if anyone cleanses himself from the latter, he will be a vessel for honor, sanctified and useful for the Master, prepared for every good work.</b>
Heb-2: 6-13	K/V- 11.	<b>For both He who sanctifies and those who are being sanctified are all of one</b> , for which reason He is not ashamed to call them brethren,
Heb-9: 11-16	K/V- 13.	For if the blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of a heifer, sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh,

Heb-10: 10-12	K/V- 10.	<b>By that will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.</b>
Heb-10: 11-20	K/V- 14.	<b>For by one offering He has perfected forever those who are being sanctified.</b>
Heb-10: 28-31	K/V- 29.	Of how much worse punishment, do you suppose, will he be thought worthy who has trampled the Son of God underfoot, <b>counted the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified a common thing, and insulted the Spirit of grace?</b>
Heb-13: 12-14	K/V- 12.	<b>Therefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people with His own blood, suffered outside the gate.</b>
1-Pet-1: 2	K/V- 2.	-elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, <b>in sanctification of the Spirit,</b> for obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace to you and peace be multiplied.
1- Pet-3: 10-16	K/V- 15.	<b>But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts,</b> and always be ready to give a defense to everyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear;
Jude-1 1-2	K/V- 1.	Jude, a bondservant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, <b>To those who are called, sanctified by God the Father, and preserved in Jesus Christ:</b>

Just: Jesus: Ministry.
