

## Scripture against Devils

Gen-3: 14-15	K/V- 15.	And I will put enmity Between you and the woman, And between your seed and her Seed; <b>He shall bruise your head, And you shall bruise His heel.</b> "
Isa-22: 19-25	K/V- 19.	<b>So I will drive you out of your office,</b> And from your position he will pull you down.
Zech-4: 6-7	K/V- 6.	So he answered and said to me: "This is the word of the Lord to Zerubbabel: ' <b>Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit,' Says the Lord of hosts. (John-6:63.)</b>
Matt-8: 28-34	K/V- 29.	And suddenly they cried out, saying, "What have we to do with You, <b>Jesus, You Son of God? Have You come here to torment us before the time?"</b>
Matt-10: 1-4	K/V- 1.	And when He had called His twelve disciples to Him, <b>He gave them power over unclean spirits, to cast them out,</b> and to heal all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease.
Matt-12: 28-30.	K/V- 28.	But if I cast out demons by the <b>Spirit of God,</b> surely the kingdom of God has come upon you. (Luke-11:20.) But if I cast out demons with the <b>finger of God,</b> surely the kingdom of God has come upon you.
Matt-16: 15-20	K/V- 19.	And I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, <b>and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven,</b> and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."
Matt-28: 18-20	K/V- 18.	And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, " <b>All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.</b>
Mark-16: 17-18	K/V- 17.	And these signs will follow those who believe: <b>In My name they will cast out demons;</b> they will speak with new tongues;
Luke-4: 18-19	K/V- 18.	"The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, Because He has anointed Me To preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, <b>To proclaim liberty to the captives</b> And recovery of sight to the blind, <b>To set at liberty those who are oppressed;</b>
Luke-9: 1-2	K/V- 1.	Then He called His twelve disciples together and <b>gave them power and authority over all demons, and to cure diseases.</b>
Luke-10: 18-20	K/V- 19.	<b>Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you. (Acts-18:9-10.)</b>
John-6: 28-29	K/V- 29.	Jesus answered and said to them, " <b>This is the work of God, that you believe in Him whom He sent.</b> "
John-8:	K/V- 32.	"And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." (John-14:6.) Jesus said to him, "I am the way, <b>the truth,</b> and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me. (John-14:15-17. <sup>17</sup> )
John-14: 9-12	K/V- 12.	"Most assuredly, <b>I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do,</b> because I go to My Father.
John-19: 29-30	K/V- 30.	So when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, " <b>It is finished!</b> " And bowing His head, He gave up His spirit. (1-Cor-2:1-5. <sup>2</sup> ) (Gal-2:20-21. <sup>20</sup> )
Rom-8: 30-31	K/V- 31.	What then shall we say to these things? <b>If God is for us, who can be against us?</b>
Rom-16: 19-20	K/V- 20.	<b>And the God of peace will crush Satan under your feet shortly.</b> The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen.
1-Cor-1: 18-21	K/V- 18.	For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, <b>but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.</b>
1-Cor-15: 24-26.	K/V- 25. K/V- 26.	<sup>25</sup> For He must reign till He has put all enemies under His feet. <sup>26</sup> The last enemy that will be destroyed is death. (1-Cor-15:55-56.)
2-Cor-2: 10-11	K/V- 11.	-lest Satan should take advantage of us; <b>for we are not ignorant of his devices. (2-Cor-11:3.)</b> But I fear, lest somehow, <b>as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, so your minds may be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ.</b>

2-Cor-10: 3-7	K/V- 4.	<b>For the weapons of our warfare are <u>not carnal</u> but <u>mighty in God</u> for pulling down strongholds,</b>
Eph-6: 10-18	K/V- 10. K/V-All.	<sup>10</sup> Finally, my brethren, be <b>strong in the Lord</b> and in the <b>power of His might.</b> <sup>11</sup> <b>Put on the whole armor of God,</b> that you may be able to <b>stand against the wiles of the devil.</b> <sup>12</sup> For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, <b>but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places.</b> <sup>13</sup> Therefore take up the <b>whole armor of God,</b> that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. <sup>14</sup> Stand therefore, <b>having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness,</b> <sup>15</sup> -and having <b>shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace;</b> <sup>16</sup> -above all, taking the <b>shield of faith</b> with which you will be able to <b>quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one.</b> <sup>17</sup> And take the <b>helmet of salvation,</b> and the <b>sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God;</b> <sup>18</sup> - <b>praying always with all prayer and supplication <u>in the Spirit,</u></b> being <b>watchful to this end</b> with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints--
Phil-2: 9-11	K/V- 10.	<sup>9</sup> Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which <b>is above every name,</b> <sup>10</sup> - <b>that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow,</b> of those <b>in heaven,</b> and of those <b>on earth,</b> and of those <b>under the earth,</b> <sup>11</sup> -and that <b>every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.</b>
Colo-2: 13-15	K/V- 15.	<b>Having disarmed principalities and powers,</b> He made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them in it.
Heb-4: 10-16	K/V- 12.	<b>For the <u>word of God is living and powerful,</u> and sharper than any <u>two-edged sword,</u> piercing even to the division of <u>soul and spirit,</u> and of joints and marrow, and is a <u>discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.</u></b>
1-John-4: 4-6	K/V- 4.	You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because <b>He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.</b>
1-John-5: 4-5	K/V- 4. K/V- 5.	<sup>4</sup> <b>For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world--<u>our faith.</u></b> <sup>5</sup> <b>Who is he who overcomes the world, <u>but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?</u></b>
Rev-12: 10-11	K/V- 11.	<b>And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death. (Matt-16:25.)</b>
Rev-12: 12-13	K/V- 12.	Therefore rejoice, O heavens, and you who dwell in them! Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and the sea! <b>For the devil has come down to you, having great wrath, because <u>he knows that he has a short time.</u></b> "
Rev-20: 10	K/V- 10.	The <b>devil, who deceived them, was cast into the lake of fire</b> and brimstone where the beast and the false prophet are. And they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.
Rev-20: 14-15	K/V- 14. K/V- 15.	<sup>14</sup> Then <b>Death and Hades were cast into the lake of fire.</b> This is the <b>second death.</b> <sup>15</sup> <b><u>And anyone not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the lake of fire.</u></b>
Acts-19: 13-18	K/V- 14. K/V- 15. K/V- 16.	<sup>14</sup> Also there were seven sons of Sceva, a Jewish chief priest, who did so. <sup>15</sup> <b>And the evil spirit answered and said, "Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are you?"</b> <sup>16</sup> Then the man in whom the evil spirit was leaped on them, <b>overpowered them, and prevailed against them, so that they fled out of that house naked and wounded.</b>
