

# Stones

Matt-3: 7-10	K/V- 9.	-and do not think to say to yourselves, 'We have Abraham as our father.' <b>For I say to you that God is able to raise up children to Abraham from these stones.</b> (Luke-3:8.)
Matt-4: 3-4	K/V- 3.	Now when the tempter came to Him, he said, "If You are the Son of God, <b>command that these stones become bread.</b> " (Luke-4:3.) (John-6:48-51.) (1-Pet-2:4-5.)
Matt-4: 5-7	K/V- 6.	-and said to Him, "If You are the Son of God, throw Yourself down. For it is written: 'He shall give His angels charge over you,' and, 'In their hands they shall bear you up, <b>Lest you dash your foot against a stone.</b> ' "(Luke-4:11.)
Matt-7: 7-11	K/V- 9.	Or what man is there among you who, <b>if his son asks for bread, will give him a stone?</b> (Luke-11:11.)
Matt-21: 42-46	K/V- 42.	Jesus said to them, "Have you never read in the Scriptures: 'The stone which the builders rejected Has become the chief cornerstone. This was the Lord's doing, And it is marvelous in our eyes'? (Mark-12:10.) (Luke-20:17.)
Matt-23: 37	K/V- 37.	"O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, <b>the one who kills the prophets and stones those who are sent to her! How often I wanted to gather your children together,</b> as a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, but you were not willing! (Luke-13:34.)
Matt-24: 1-2	K/V- 2.	And Jesus said to them, "Do you not see all these things? Assuredly, <b>I say to you, not one stone shall be left here upon another, that shall not be thrown down.</b> " (Mark-13:1-2.) (Luke-19:44.) (Luke-21:6.)
Matt-27: 59-66	K/V- 60.	-and laid it in his new tomb which he had hewn out of the rock; <b>and he rolled a large stone against the door of the tomb, and departed.</b> (Mk-15:46.) (Lk-24:2.) (Jn-11:38.)
Matt-28: 1-15	K/V- 2.	And behold, there was a great earthquake; <b>for an angel of the Lord descended from heaven, and came and rolled back the stone from the door, and sat on it.</b> (Mk-16:3-4.) (Jn-20:1.)
Mark-5: 1-6	K/V- 5.	And always, night and day, he was in the mountains and in the tombs, <b>crying out and cutting himself with stones.</b>
Mark-12: 1-11	K/V- 4.	Again he sent them another servant, <b>and at him they threw stones,</b> wounded him in the head, and sent him away shamefully treated.
Luke-19: 39-40	K/V- 40.	But He answered and said to them, " <b>I tell you that if these should keep silent, the stones would immediately cry out.</b> "
Luke-19: 44	K/V- 44.	-and level you, and your children within you, to the ground; <b>and they will not leave in you one stone upon another, because you did not know the time of your visitation."</b>
Luke-20: 1-8	K/V- 6.	<b>But if we say, 'From men,' all the people will stone us,</b> for they are persuaded that John was a prophet."
John-2: 1-11	K/V- 6.	<b>Now there were set there six water pots of stone,</b> according to the manner of purification of the Jews, containing twenty or thirty gallons apiece.
John-8: 7-8	K/V- 7.	So when they continued asking Him, He raised Himself up and said to them, " <b>He who is without sin among you, let him throw a stone at her first.</b> " (Rom-3:23.)
John-8: 54-59	K/V- 59.	<b>Then they took up stones to throw at Him;</b> but Jesus hid Himself and went out of the temple, going through the midst of them, and so passed by.
John-10: 24-33	K/V- 32.	Jesus answered them, " <b>Many good works I have shown you from My Father. For which of those works do you stone Me?</b> "
John-11: 38-47	K/V- 38.	Then Jesus, again groaning in Himself, came to the tomb. It was a cave, <b>and a stone lay against it.</b>
Rom-9: 31-33	K/V- 33.	As it is written: "Behold, <b>I lay in Zion a stumbling stone and rock of offense,</b> And whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame." (Gal-5:11.)
2-Cor-3: 1-3	K/V- 3.	-clearly you are an epistle of Christ, ministered by us, written not with ink but by the Spirit of the living God, not on tablets of <b>stone</b> but on tablets of flesh, that is, of the heart.
