

# Suffering

Matt-11: 11-15	K/V- 12.	<b>And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffers violence, and the violent take it by force.</b>
Matt-16 21-28	K/V- 21.	From that time Jesus began to show to His disciples that He must go to Jerusalem, <b>and suffer many things from the elders and chief priests and scribes</b> , and be killed, and be raised the third day. (Mk-8:31.) (Lk-9:22.)
Matt-17: 10-13	K/V- 12.	But I say to you that Elijah has come already, and they did not know him but did to him whatever they wished. <b>Likewise the Son of Man is also about to suffer at their hands.</b> " (Mk-9:12.)
Matt-17: 14-21	K/V- 15.	"Lord, have mercy on my son, <b>for he is an epileptic and suffers severely</b> ; for he often falls into the fire and often into the water.
Matt-27: 19	K/V- 19.	While he was sitting on the judgment seat, his wife sent to him, saying, "Have nothing to do with that just Man, for I have <b>suffered</b> many things today in a dream because of Him."
Mark-5: 25-34	K/V- 26.	<b>-and had suffered many things from many physicians.</b> She had spent all that she had and was no better, but rather grew worse.
Luke-13: 1-5	K/V- 2.	And Jesus answered and said to them, "Do you suppose that these Galileans were worse sinners than all other Galileans, <b>because they suffered such things?</b>
Luke-17: 22-37	K/V- 25.	<b>But first He must suffer many things and be rejected by this generation.</b> (Mk-8:31.) (Mk-9:31.) (Mk-10:33.) (Lk-9:22.)
Luke-22: 13-23	K/V- 15.	Then He said to them, " <b>With fervent desire I have desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer;</b>
Luke-24: 25-26	K/V- 26.	<b>Ought not the Christ to have suffered these things and to enter into His glory?"</b> (Acts-1:1-3.) (Acts-3:18.)
Luke-24: 44-49	K/V- 46.	Then He said to them, " <b>Thus it is written, and thus it was necessary for the Christ to suffer and to rise from the dead the third day,</b> (Acts-26:23.) (Rom-10:9.)
Acts-5: 39-42	K/V- 41.	So they departed from the presence of the council, <b>rejoicing that they were counted worthy to suffer shame for His name.</b> (Acts-9:15-16.) (Heb-12:4-6.)
Acts-28: 1-6	K/V- 5.	<b>But he shook off the creature into the fire and suffered no harm.</b> (Mk-16:18.)
Rom-8: 16-19	K/V- 17.	-and if children, then heirs--heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, <b>if indeed we suffer with Him, that we may also be glorified together.</b> (Phili-1:29.)
1-Cor-3: 11-16	K/V- 15.	If anyone's work is burned, <b>he will suffer loss</b> ; but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire.
1-Cor-12: 25-27	K/V- 26.	<b>And if one member suffers, all the members suffer with it</b> ; or if one member is honored, all the members rejoice with it.
1-Cor-13: 1-13	K/V- 4.	<b>Love suffers long and is kind</b> ; love does not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up;
2-Cor-1: 2-10	K/V- 5.	<b>For as the sufferings of Christ abound in us</b> , so our consolation also abounds through Christ.
2-Cor-7: 6-15	K/V- 9.	Now I rejoice, not that you were made sorry, but that your sorrow led to repentance. For you were made sorry in a godly manner, <b>that you might suffer loss from us in nothing.</b>
Gal-3: 1-6	K/V- 4.	<b>Have you suffered so many things in vain--</b> if indeed it was in vain?
Gal-5: 6-14	K/V- 11.	And I, brethren, if I still preach circumcision, <b>why do I still suffer persecution?</b> Then the offense of the cross has ceased.
Gal-5: 22-23	K/V- 22.	But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, <b>longsuffering</b> , kindness, goodness, faithfulness,
Gal-6: 12-28	K/V- 12.	As many as desire to make a good showing in the flesh, these would compel you to be circumcised, <b>only that they may not suffer persecution for the cross of Christ.</b>

Phili-3: 7-11	K/V- 8.	Yet indeed I also count all things loss for the excellence of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord, <b>for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them as rubbish, that I may gain Christ (Matt-19:29.) (Mk-10:29-31.)</b>
Phili-4: 11-13	K/V- 12.	I know how to be abased, and I know how to abound. Everywhere and in all things I have learned both to be full and to be hungry, <b>both to abound and to suffer need.</b>
Col-1: 24-26	K/V- 24.	<b>I now rejoice in my sufferings for you,</b> and fill up in my flesh what is lacking in the afflictions of Christ, for the sake of His body, which is the church,
1-Thes-2: 1-2	K/V- 2.	<b>But even after we had suffered before and were spitefully treated at Philippi,</b> as you know, we were bold in our God to speak to you the gospel of God in much conflict.
1-Thes-3: 1-5	K/V- 4.	<b>For, in fact, we told you before when we were with you that we would suffer tribulation,</b> just as it happened, and you know.
2-Thes-1: 3-7	K/V- 5.	-which is manifest evidence of the righteous judgment of God, <b>that you may be counted worthy of the kingdom of God, for which you also suffer;</b>
1-Tim-1: 18-20	K/V- 19.	-having faith and a good conscience, which some having rejected, <b>concerning the faith have suffered shipwreck,</b>
1-Tim-4: 9-11	K/V- 10.	<b>For to this end we both labor and suffer reproach,</b> because we trust in the living God, who is the Savior of all men, especially of those who believe.
2-Tim-1: 7-12	K/V- 8.	Therefore do not be ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me His prisoner, <b>but share with me in the sufferings for the gospel according to the power of God,</b>
2-Tim-2: 7-13	K/V- 9.	<b>-for which I suffer trouble as an evildoer, even to the point of chains; but the word of God is not chained. (Matt-5:11.) (Lk-6:22.)</b>
2-Tim-3: 12	K/V- 12.	<b>Yes, and all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will suffer persecution.</b>
Heb-2: 6-9	K/V- 9.	But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels, <b>for the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, that He, by the grace of God, might taste death for everyone. (1-Cor-15:16.)</b>
Heb-2: 14-18	K/V- 18.	<b>For in that He Himself has suffered,</b> being tempted, He is able to aid those who are tempted.
Heb-5: 3-10	K/V- 8.	-though He was a Son, yet <b>He learned obedience by the things which He suffered.</b>
Heb-9: 24-27	K/V- 26.	<b>He then would have had to suffer often since the foundation of the world;</b> but now, once at the end of the ages, He has appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself.
Heb-10: 30-35	K/V- 32.	But recall the former days in which, <b>after you were illuminated, you endured a great struggle with sufferings:</b>
Heb-11: 24-27	K/V- 25.	<b>-choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God than to enjoy the passing pleasures of sin,</b>
Heb-13: 12	K/V- 12.	Therefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people with His own blood, <b>suffered outside the gate.</b>
James-5: 9-12	K/V- 10.	My brethren, take the prophets, who spoke in the name of the Lord, <b>as an example of suffering and patience.</b>
James-5: 13-15	K/V- 13.	<b>Is anyone among you suffering? Let him pray.</b> Is anyone cheerful? Let him sing psalms.
1-Pet-1: 9-11	K/V- 11.	-searching what, or what manner of time, <b>the Spirit of Christ who was in them was indicating when He testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ and the glories that would follow.</b>
1-Pet-2: 18-25	K/V- 20.	For what credit is it if, when you are beaten for your faults, you take it patiently? <b>But when you do good and suffer, if you take it patiently,</b> this is commendable before God.
1-Pet-2: 24	K/V- 24.	<b>-who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree,</b> that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness--by whose stripes you were healed.
1-Pet-3: 10-14	K/V- 14.	<b>But even if you should suffer for righteousness' sake, you are blessed.</b> "And do not be afraid of their threats, nor be troubled."

1-Pet-3: 15-19	K/V- 17.	For it is better, if it is the will of God, <b>to suffer for doing good than for doing evil.</b>
1-Pet-4: 1-5	K/V- 1.	<b>Therefore, since Christ suffered for us in the flesh, arm yourselves also with the same mind, for he who has suffered in the flesh has ceased from sin,</b>
1-Pet-4: 12-19	K/V- 13.	<b>-but rejoice to the extent that you partake of Christ's sufferings,</b> that when His glory is revealed, you may also be glad with exceeding joy.
1-Pet-5: 1-14	K/V- 9.	<b>Resist him, steadfast in the faith, knowing that the same sufferings are experienced by your brotherhood in the world.</b>
Jude-7:	K/V- 7.	-as Sodom and Gomorrah, and the cities around them in a similar manner to these, having given themselves over to sexual immorality and gone after strange flesh, are set forth as an example, <b>suffering the vengeance of eternal fire.</b>
Rev-2: 10	K/V- 10.	<b>Do not fear any of those things which you are about to suffer.</b> Indeed, the devil is about to throw some of you into prison, that you may be tested, and you will have tribulation ten days. Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life.
