

# Test

Matt-16: 1-4	K/V- 1.	Then the Pharisees and Sadducees came, <b>and testing Him asked that He would show them a sign from heaven.</b> (Mk-8:11-12.) (Lk-11:16.)
Matt-19: 3-10	K/V- 3.	<b>The Pharisees also came to Him, testing Him,</b> and saying to Him, "Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife for just any reason?" (Mk-10:2-12.)
Matt-22: 15-22	K/V- 18.	But Jesus perceived their wickedness, and said, " <b>Why do you test Me, you hypocrites?</b> " (Mk-12:13-17. <sup>15</sup> ) (Lk-20:21-26. <sup>23</sup> )
Matt-22: 34-40	K/V- 35. K/V- 36.	<sup>35</sup> . Then one of them, a lawyer, asked Him a question, <b>testing Him, and saying,</b> <sup>36</sup> . "Teacher, which is the great commandment in the law?"
Luke-10: 25-37	K/V- 25.	<b>And behold, a certain lawyer stood up and tested Him,</b> saying, "Teacher, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?"
John-6: 5-14	K/V- 6.	<b>But this He said to test him,</b> for He Himself knew what He would do.
John-8: 1-11	K/V- 6.	This they said, <b>testing Him,</b> that they might have something of which to accuse Him. But Jesus stooped down and wrote on the ground with His finger, as though He did not hear.
Acts-5: 1-11	K/V- 9.	Then Peter said to her, " <b>How is it that you have agreed together to test the Spirit of the Lord?</b> Look, the feet of those who have buried your husband are at the door, and they will carry you out."
Acts-15: 1-11	K/V- 10.	Now therefore, <b>why do you test God by putting a yoke on the neck of the disciples which neither our fathers nor we were able to bear?</b>
1-Cor-3: 10-16	K/V- 13.	-each one's work will become clear; for the Day will declare it, because it will be revealed by fire; <b>and the fire will test each one's work,</b> of what sort it is.
2-Cor-2: 1-9	K/V- 9.	For to this end I also wrote, <b>that I might put you to the test, whether you are obedient in all things.</b>
2-Cor-8: 7-11	K/V- 8.	<b>I speak not by commandment, but I am testing the sincerity of your love by the diligence of others.</b>
1-Thes-2: 1-7	K/V- 4.	But as we have been approved by God to be entrusted with the gospel, <b>even so we speak, not as pleasing men, but God who tests our hearts.</b>
1-Thes-5: 19-22	K/V- 21.	<b>Test all things; hold fast what is good.</b>
Heb-3: 7-12	K/V- 9.	<b>Where your fathers tested Me, tried Me,</b> And saw My works forty years.
Heb-11: 17	K/V- 17.	<b>By faith Abraham, when he was tested,</b> offered up Isaac, and he who had received the promises offered up his only begotten son,
James-1: 1-4	K/V- 3.	<b>-knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience.</b>
1-Pet-1: 3-9	K/V- 7.	-that the genuineness of your faith, being much more precious than gold that perishes, <b>though it is tested by fire,</b> may be found to praise, honor, and glory at the revelation of Jesus Christ,
1-John-4: 1-3	K/V- 1.	Beloved, <b>do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits,</b> whether they are of God; because many false prophets have gone out into the world.
Rev-2: 2-3	K/V- 2.	I know your works, your labor, your patience, and that you cannot bear those who are evil. And you have <u>tested</u> those who say they are apostles and are not, and have found them liars;
Rev-2: 10	K/V- 10.	Do not fear any of those things which you are about to suffer. Indeed, the devil is about to throw some of you into prison, <b>that you may be tested,</b> and you will have tribulation ten days. Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life.
Rev-3: 10	K/V- 10.	Because you have kept My command to persevere, I also will keep you from the hour of trial which shall come upon the whole world, <b>to test those who dwell on the earth.</b>
