Mat-5: 43-48	K/V- 44.	But I say to you, love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you,
Mat-6: 21-24	K/V- 24.	“No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or else he will be loyal to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon. (<u>1-Tim-6:6-12.^{10.}</u>)
Mat-10: 16-23	K/V- 22.	“And you will be hated by all for My name’s sake. But he who endures to the end will be saved.
Mat-10: 32-39	K/V- 37.	“He who loves father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me. And he who loves son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.
Mat-24: 9-10	K/V- 9.	“Then they will deliver you up to tribulation and kill you, and you will be hated by all nations for My name’s sake. (<u>Mk-13:13.</u>) (<u>Lk-21:17.</u>) (<u>Mat-10:28.</u>)
Lk-6 22-23	K/V- 22.	Blessed are you when men hate you, And when they exclude you, And revile you, and cast out your name as evil, For the Son of Man’s sake. (<u>Jn-16:1-3.</u>)
Lk-6: 26-228	K/V- 26.	Woe to you when all men speak well of you, For so did their fathers to the false prophets.
Lk-9: 23-27	K/V- 23.	Then He said to them all, “If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me.
Lk-14: 15-24	K/V- 18.	“But they all with one accord began to make excuses. The first said to him, ‘I have bought a piece of ground, and I must go and see it. I ask you to have me excused.’

Gal-1: 6-12	K/V- 10.	For do I now persuade men, or God? Or do I seek to please men? For if I still pleased men, I would not be a bondservant of Christ. (<u>Lk-16:15.</u>)
