

The power of words and agreement. (Beware.)

Brothers and sisters I am teaching on this subject because of how many times my assistant Hekoi Mills and I have been invited to and visited many churches and people's homes, and just listening to them, it is not hard to discern that many do not believe Jesus who gave us the word of God, And I am talking about many who claim to be Christian. I will now give you some scripture to show you how easy that we can be robbed of the simplicity that is in Christ. (2-Cor-11:3-4) **3.** But I fear, lest somehow, as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, so your minds may be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ. **4.** For if he who comes preaches another Jesus whom we have not preached, or if you receive a different spirit which you have not received, or a different gospel which you have not accepted--you may well put up with it! **Comment:** Brothers and sister we all need to check ourselves and check those who teach us. Is your faith in the Lord Jesus Christ getting stronger or not, look at this scripture. (1-John-2:6.) **6.** He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to walk just as He walked. **Comment:** Are you becoming more like your Master Jesus or not. **Warning:** (Matt-24:24.) **24.** For false christs and false prophets will rise and show great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect.

Matt-4: 1-4	K/V- 4.	4. But He answered and said, "It is written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God. ' " <u>(Matt-4:10-11.)</u> 10. Then Jesus said to him, "Away with you, Satan! For it is written, ' You shall worship the Lord your God, and Him only you shall serve. ' " 11. Then the devil left Him, and behold, angels came and ministered to Him.
Matt-6: 7-8	K/V-7.	7. And when you pray, do not use vain repetitions as the heathen do. For they think that they will be heard for their many words. 8. Therefore do not be like them. For your Father knows the things you have need of before you ask Him.
Matt-8: 5-13	K/V- 8.	8. The centurion answered and said, "Lord, I am not worthy that You should come under my roof. But only speak a word, and my servant will be healed. <u>(Lk-7:7.)</u>
Matt-8: 16-17	K/V- 16.	16. When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick,
Matt-10: 14-15	K/V- 14.	14. And whoever will not receive you nor hear your words, when you depart from that house or city, shake off the dust from your feet. Comment: Jesus is talking about the words that He taught them. <u>(Matt-28:18-20.)</u> 20. Teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.
Matt-12: 36-37	K/V: 36. K/V: 37.	36. But I say to you that for <u>every idle word men may speak,</u> they will give account of it in the day of judgment. 37. For by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned." <u>(Prov-18:21.)</u> Death and life are in the power of the tongue, And those who love it will eat its fruit.
Matt-13: 18-23	K/V- 19.	19. When anyone hears the word of the kingdom, and does not understand it, then the wicked one comes and snatches away what was sown in his heart. This is he who received seed by the wayside. <u>(Mk-4:15.)</u> <u>(Lk-8:11-15.)</u>
Matt-24: 35	K/V- 35.	35. Heaven and earth will pass away, but <u>(My words)</u> will by no means pass away. <u>(Mk-13:31.)</u> <u>(Lk-21:33.)</u> Comment: Jesus said My words
Mark-7: 9-13	K/V- 13.	13. Making the word of God of no effect through your tradition which you have handed down. And many such things you do." <u>(Lk-14:27.)</u> 27. And whoever does not bear his cross and come after Me cannot be My disciple.
Mark-8: 32-38	K/V- 38.	38. For whoever is ashamed of Me and My words in this adulterous and sinful generation, of him the Son of Man also will be ashamed when He comes in the glory of His Father with

		the holy angels." (<u>Lk-9:26-27.</u>) (<u>Matt-10:32-33.</u>) 32. "Therefore whoever confesses Me before men, him I will also confess before My Father who is in heaven. 33. But whoever denies Me before men, him I will also deny before My Father who is in heaven.
Mark-16: 15-20	K/V- 20.	20. And they went out and preached everywhere, the Lord working with them and confirming the word through the accompanying signs. Amen. (<u>1-Cor-2:4-5.</u>) (<u>1-Cor-4:19.</u>)
Luke-4: 31-37	K/V- 32.	32. And they were astonished at His teaching, for <u>His word</u> was with authority.
Luke-5: 1-11	K/V- 5.	5. But Simon answered and said to Him, "Master, we have toiled all night and caught nothing; nevertheless at Your word I will let down the net."
Luke-8: 19-21	K/V- 21.	21. But He answered and said to them, " My mother and My brothers are these who <u>hear the word of God and do it.</u> " (<u>Lk-11:27-28.</u>)
Luke-11: 27-28	K/V- 28.	28. But He said, "More than that, blessed are those who hear the word of God and keep it! "
John-1: 1-3	K/V- 1.	1. In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
John-1: 12-14	K/V- 14.	14. And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.
John-3: 29-33	K/V- 31.	31. He who comes from above is above all; he who is of the earth is earthly and speaks of the earth. He who comes from heaven is above all.
John-3: 33-36	K/V- 34.	34. For He whom God has sent speaks the words of God, for God does not give the Spirit by measure.
John-4: 46-54	K/V- 50.	50. Jesus said to him, "Go your way; your son lives." So the man <u>believed the word that Jesus spoke to him,</u> and he went his way.
John-5: 24	K/V- 24.	"Most assuredly, I say to you, he who hears <u>My word</u> and believes in Him who sent Me has everlasting life, and shall not come into judgment, but has passed from death into life.
John-5: 36-39	K/V- 38.	38. But you do not have His word abiding in you, because whom He sent, Him you do not believe.
John-6: 28-29	K/V- 29.	29. Jesus answered and said to them, " This is the work of God, that you <u>believe in Him whom He sent.</u> "
John-6: 63-64	K/V- 63.	63. It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. <u>The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life.</u> (<u>Rom-8:14.</u>)
John-6: 67-71	K/V- 68.	68. But Simon Peter answered Him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life.
John-8: 28-36	K/V- 31.	31. Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, " If you abide in <u>My word,</u> you are My disciples indeed.
John-8: 49-59	K/V- 51.	51. Most assuredly, I say to you, if anyone keeps <u>My word</u> he shall never see death. " (<u>John-11:25-26.</u>) 25. Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live. 26. And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die. Do you believe this?" (<u>1-Thes-4:17.</u>)
John-12: 47-50	K/V- 48.	48. He who rejects Me, and <u>does not receive My words,</u> has that which judges him--the word that I have spoken will judge him in the last day. (<u>Luke-2:34.</u>)
John-14: 6	K/V- 6.	6. Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me. (<u>Heb-13:8.</u>) 8. Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.
John-14: 10-12	K/V- 10.	10. Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own authority; but the Father who dwells in Me does the works. (<u>Deut-18:18-19.</u>)

John-14: 23-26	K/V- 23.	23. Jesus answered and said to him, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him.
John-15: 1-15	K/V- 3.	3. You are already clean because of the word which (I) have spoken to you. (<u>Acts-2:38.</u>) (<u>Acts-22:14-16.</u>) (<u>Eph-5:26.</u>) (<u>Rev-7:14.</u>)
John-17: 1-10	K/V- 6.	6. "I have manifested Your name to the men whom You have given Me out of the world. They were Yours, You gave them to Me, and they have kept Your word.
John-17: 10-26	K/V- 17.	17. Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth. (<u>John-3:34.</u>)
Acts-2: 38-47	K/V- 41.	41. Then those who gladly received his word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added to them. (<u>Mk-16:16.</u>) (<u>Acts-4:4.</u>)
Acts-4: 29-37	K/V- 29.	29. Now, Lord, look on their threats, and grant to Your servants that with all boldness they may speak Your word, (<u>Acts-5:20.</u>)
Acts-11: 12-17	K/V- 14. K/V- 15.	14. Who will tell you words by which you and all your household will be saved.' 15. And as I began to speak, the Holy Spirit fell upon them, as upon us at the beginning.
Acts-14: 1-4	K/V- 3.	3. Therefore they stayed there a long time, speaking boldly in the Lord, who was bearing witness to the word of His grace, granting signs and wonders to be done by their hands.
Acts-15: 24	K/V- 24.	24. Since we have heard that some who went out from us have troubled you with words, unsettling your souls, saying, "You must be circumcised and keep the law"--to whom we gave no such commandment—(<u>Matt-16:12.</u>) (<u>Gal-5:4.</u>) (<u>Heb-10:11-12.</u>)
		<u>Don't agree with everyone.</u>
Matt-18: 18-20	K/V- 19.	19. Again I say to you that if two of you agree on earth concerning anything that they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in heaven.
1-Cor-15: 33-34	K/V- 33.	33. Do not be deceived: " Evil company corrupts good habits. "
2-Cor-6: 14-18	K/V- 16.	16. And what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For you are the temple of the living God. As God has said: "I will dwell in them And walk among them. I will be their God, And they shall be My people."
Gal-1: 6-12	K/V- 8.	8. But even if we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel to you than what we have preached to you, let him be accursed. (<u>2-Cor-11:14-15.</u>) 14. And no wonder! For Satan himself transforms himself into an angel of light. 15. Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also transform themselves into ministers of righteousness, whose end will be according to their works.
Jam-3: 1-18	K/V- 8. K/V- 9. K/V- 10.	8. But no man can tame the tongue. It is an unruly evil, full of deadly poison. 9. With it we bless our God and Father, and with it we curse men, who have been made in the similitude of God. 10. Out of the same mouth proceed blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not to be so.

Brothers and sisters people say to me how do you know if you are in the right church or if you are with the right people, I tell them well first of all if you are in the right place you will decrease, and your faith in Jesus Christ will increase. John said in (Jn-3:30.) "He must increase, but I must decrease. In (1-Jn-2:6.) says: He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to walk just as He walked.
