

## Tithes & Offerings

Gen-14: 18-20	K/V- 20.	And blessed be God Most High, Who has delivered your enemies into your hand." <b>And he gave him a tithe of all.</b> ( <u>Lev-27:28-34.<sup>31</sup></u> ) (Heb-7:4.)
Deut-26: 8-19	K/V- 12.	<b>"When you have finished laying aside all the tithe of your increase in the third year--the year of tithing--and have given it to the Levite, the stranger, the fatherless, and the widow, so that they may eat within your gates and be filled,</b> ( <u>Jam-1:27.</u> )
2-Chr-31: 1-12	K/V- 5.	As soon as the commandment was circulated, <b>the children of Israel brought in abundance the first fruits of grain and wine, oil and honey, and of all the produce of the field; and they brought in abundantly the tithe of everything.</b>
Neh- 10: 37	K/V- 37.	-to bring the <b>first fruits</b> of our dough, our offerings, the fruit from all kinds of trees, the new wine and oil, to the priests, to the storerooms of the house of our God; <b>and to bring the tithes of our land to the Levites, for the Levites should receive the tithes in all our farming communities.</b> ( <u>Nehe-12:44.</u> ) ( <u>Nehe-13:5.</u> ) ( <u>Nehe-13:12.</u> )
Mal-3: 6-18	K/V- 10.	<b>Bring all the tithes into the storehouse,</b> That there may be food in My house, And try Me now in this," Says the Lord of hosts, "If I will not open for you the windows of heaven And pour out for you such blessing That there will not be room enough to receive it.
Matt-17: 24-27	K/V- 25.	He said, "Yes." And when he had come into the house, Jesus anticipated him, saying, "What do you think, Simon? <b>From whom do the kings of the earth take customs or taxes, from their sons or from strangers?"</b>
Matt-23: 23-24	K/V- 23.	Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! <b>For you pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin,</b> and have neglected the weightier matters of the law: justice and mercy and faith. These you ought to have done, without leaving the others undone. ( <u>Lk-11:42.</u> )
Mark-12: 41-44	K/V- 42.	Then one poor widow came and threw in <b>two mites</b> , which make a quadrans. ( <u>Lk-21:1-4.</u> )
Luke-18: 9-14	K/V- 12.	I fast twice a week; <b>I give tithes of all that I possess.'</b>
Acts-4: 34-37	K/V- 35.	<b>-and laid them at the apostles' feet; and they distributed to each as anyone had need.</b>
Acts-20: 35	K/V- 35.	I have shown you in every way, by laboring like this, that you must support the weak. And remember the words of the Lord Jesus, that He said, <b>'It is more blessed to give than to receive.'</b> "
2-Cor-9: 5-8	K/V- 7.	<b>So let each one give as he purposes in his heart,</b> not grudgingly or of necessity; <b>for God loves a cheerful giver.</b>
1-Tim-5: 8	K/V- 8.	<b>But if anyone does not provide for his own,</b> and especially for those of his household, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.
1-Jn-3: 17-19	K/V- 17.	<b>But whoever has this world's goods, and sees his brother in need, and shuts up his heart from him, how does the love of God abide in him?</b>
Mark-4: 22-23	K/V- 22.	<b>For there is nothing hidden which will not be revealed,</b> nor has anything been kept secret but that it should come to light. ( <u>Lk-8:17-18.</u> )
Luke-12: 1-3	K/V- 2.	<b>For there is nothing covered that will not be revealed,</b> nor hidden that will not be known.
Heb-4: 12-13	K/V- 13.	<b>And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things are naked and open to the eyes of Him to whom we must give account.</b>
