| Mark-7: 1-13 | K/V- 8. K/V- 9. | ^{8.} "For laying aside the commandment of God, <u>you hold the traditions of men-</u> the washing of pitchers and cups, and many other such things you do." ^{9.} He said to them, "All too well you <u>reject the commandment of God, that you may keep your tradition.</u> |
| Mark-7: 13-16 | K/V- 13. | ---" making the <u>word of God of no effect through your tradition</u> which you have handed down. And many such things you do. |
| Acts-15: 23-24 | K/V- 24. | Since we have heard that some who went out from us have troubled you with words, unsettling your souls, saying, " You must be circumcised and keep the law "- to whom <u>we gave no such commandment-</u> (Jn-1:17.) (Gal-5:4.) (Heb-8:6-13. ^{7.}) |
| 1-Cor-5: 1-13 | K/V- 6. | Your glorying is not good. Do you not know that a little leaven leavens the whole lump? (Matt-16:5-12. ^{6.}) (Leaven: Doctrine.) |
| 1-Cor-5: 11-13 | K/V- 11. | But now I have written to you not to keep company with anyone named a brother, who is sexually immoral, or covetous, or an idolater, or a reviler, or a drunkard, or an extortioner- not even to eat with such a person. (1-Cor-15:33-34. ^{33.}) (Gal-5:18-26. ^{21.}) |
| 1-Cor-11: 1-4 | K/V- 1. K/V- 2. | ^{1.} Imitate me, just as I imitate Christ. ^{2.} Now I praise you, brethren, that you remember me in all things and keep the traditions just as <u>I delivered them to you.</u> (Jn-15:4.) (1-Jn-2:6.) |
| Gal-1: 6-12 | K/V- 10. | For do I now persuade men, or God? Or do I seek to please men? For if I still please men, I would not be a bondservant of Christ. |
| Eph-5: 1-20 | K/V- 18. | And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit, (John-6:63.) |
| Colo-2: 8 | K/V- 8. | Beware lest anyone cheats you through philosophy and empty deceit, according to the traditions of men, according to the basic principles of the world, and not according to Christ. |
| Col-2: 20-23 | K/V- 22. | ---Which all concern things which perish with the using- according to the commandments and doctrines of men. (Heb-6:1-3.) |
| 2-Thes-3: 6-9 | K/V- 6. | But we command you, brethren, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ that you withdrew from every brother who walks disorderly and <u>not according to the tradition which he received from us.</u> |
| Titus-1: 10-16 | K/V- 14. | Not giving heed to Jewish fables and <u>commandments of men</u> who turn from the truth. (Mat-16:23.) (Mk-8:32-33.) |
| Heb-6: 1-3 | K/V- 1. | Therefore, leaving the discussion of the elementary principles of Christ, let us go on to perfection, not laying again the foundations of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God, |
| 1-Pet-1: 16-19 | K/V- 18. | Knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver or gold, from your aimless conduct received by <u>tradition from your fathers.</u> (Jn-4:23-24.) |
| 1-Pet-4: 1-7 | K/V- 3. K/V- 4. | ^{3.} For we have spent enough of our past lifetime in <u>doing the will of the Gentiles-</u> when we walked in lewdness, lust, drunkenness, revelries, drinking parties, and abominable idolatries. ^{4.} In regard to these, they think it strange that you do not run with them in the same flood of dissipation, speaking evil of you. |

| Lev-19: 28-29 | K/V- 28. | ‘You shall not make any cuttings in your flesh for the dead, nor tattoo any marks on you: I am the Lord. (If you have tattoo’s or cuttings on you don’t worry about it, all this is in the past. From now on you should be working on the inner man, feeding on Jesus not on the outer man which is dying daily.) (Jam-4:4.) (1-Jn-2:15-17.) |
| Luke-6: 46-49 | K/V- 46. | “But why do you call <u>Me ‘Lord, Lord,’</u> and not do the things which <u>I say?</u>” |
| Jn-7 22-24 | K/V- 22. | “Moses therefore gave you circumcision (not that it is from Moses, <u>but from the fathers</u>), and you circumcise a man on the Sabbath. |
| 1-Cor-3: 16-17 | K/V- 16. | Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the <u>Spirit of God dwells in you?</u> (John-6:53.) (Rom-8:14.) (1-Cor-6:19-20.) |
| 1-Jn-1: 5-9 | K/V- 6. | If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, <u>we lie and do not practice the truth.</u> (John-8:44.) |
| 1-Jn-2: 1-6 | K/V- 4. | He who says, “I know Him,” and does not keep His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him. (2-Cor-13:5.) |
