

# Trees

Gen-2: 9	K/V- 9.	And out of the ground the Lord God made every tree grow that is pleasant to the sight and good for food. The tree of life was also in the midst of the garden, <b>and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.</b>
Gen-3: 1-7	K/V- 3.	<b>-but of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God has said, 'You shall not eat it, nor shall you touch it, lest you die.'</b> <u>“(Gen-2:16-17.)</u>
Jud-9: 7-15	K/V- 8.	<b>"The trees once went forth to anoint a king over them.</b> And they said to the olive tree, 'Reign over us!'
Psa-1: 1-3	K/V- 3.	<b>He shall be like a tree Planted by the rivers of water,</b> That brings forth its fruit in its season, Whose leaf also shall not wither; And whatever he does shall prosper. <u>(Jn-7:38.)</u>
Psa-37: 34-36	K/V- 35.	I have seen the wicked in great power, <b>And spreading himself like a native green tree.</b>
Psa-52: 7-9	K/V- 8.	<b>But I am like a green olive tree in the house of God;</b> I trust in the mercy of God forever and ever. <u>(Matt-24:3.)</u>
Psa-92: 12-15	K/V- 12.	<b>The righteous shall flourish like a palm tree, He shall grow like a cedar in Lebanon.</b>
Prov-11: 30	K/V- 30.	<b>The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life, And he who wins souls is wise.</b>
Prov-13: 12	K/V- 12.	Hope deferred makes the heart sick, <b>But when the desire comes, it is a tree of life.</b>
Isa-61: 1-4	K/V- 3.	To console those who mourn in Zion, To give them beauty for ashes, The oil of joy for mourning, The garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; <b>That they may be called trees of righteousness, The planting of the Lord, that He may be glorified."</b>
Jer-11: 16-23	K/V- 16.	The Lord called your name, <b>Green Olive Tree, Lovely and of Good Fruit.</b> With the noise of a great tumult He has kindled fire on it, And its branches are broken.
Matt-3: 7-10	K/V- 10.	And even now the ax is laid to the root of the trees. <b>Therefore every tree which does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire.</b> <u>(Matt-7:19.)</u>
Matt-7: 15-21	K/V- 17.	Even so, <b>every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit.</b> <u>(Luke-6:43-49.<sup>43</sup>) (Gal-5:22-23.)</u>
Matt-12: 32-33	K/V- 33.	<b>"Either make the tree good and its fruit good, or else make the tree bad and its fruit bad; for a tree is known by its fruit.</b> <u>(Gal-5:19-23.)</u>
Matt-15: 13-14	K/V- 13.	But He answered and said, <b>"Every plant which My heavenly Father has not planted will be uprooted.</b>
Matt-21: 18-22	K/V- 19.	And seeing a <b>fig tree</b> by the road, He came to it and found nothing on it but leaves, and said to it, <b>"Let no fruit grow on you ever again."</b> <b>Immediately the fig tree withered away.</b> <u>(Matt-25:25.) (Mk-11:12-14.) (Lk-14:16-24.<sup>18</sup>)</u>
Matt-24: 32-35	K/V- 32.	<b>"Now learn this parable from the fig tree:</b> When its branch has already become tender and puts forth leaves, you know that summer is near.
Mark-8: 22-26	K/V- 24.	And he looked up and said, <b>"I see men like trees, walking."</b> <u>(Isa-61:3.) (Jn-15:1.)</u>
Luke-13: 6-9	K/V- 6.	He also spoke this parable: <b>"A certain man had a fig tree planted in his vineyard, and he came seeking fruit on it and found none.</b>
Luke-13: 18-19.	K/V- 19.	It is like a mustard seed, which a man took and put in his garden; <b>and it grew and became a large tree, and the birds of the air nested in its branches."</b>
Luke-17: 5-6	K/V- 6.	So the Lord said, "If you have faith as a mustard seed, <b>you can say to this mulberry tree, 'Be pulled up by the roots and be planted in the sea,' and it would obey you.</b>

Luke-19: 1-10	K/V- 4.	<b>So he ran ahead and climbed up into a sycamore tree to see Him</b> , for He was going to pass that way.
Luke-21: 19-36	K/V- 29.	Then He spoke to them a parable: " <b>Look at the fig tree, and all the trees.</b> "
Luke-23: 27-31	K/V- 31.	For if they do these things in the <b>green wood</b> , what will be done in the dry?"
John-1: 45-51	K/V- 48.	Nathanael said to Him, "How do You know me?" Jesus answered and said to him, "Before Philip called you, <b>when you were under the fig tree, I saw you.</b> " (Heb-4:13.)
John-15: 1-10	K/V- 1.	<b>"I am the true vine</b> , and My Father is the vinedresser.
Acts-5: 29-32	K/V- 30.	The God of our fathers raised up Jesus whom you <b>murdered by hanging on a tree.</b> (Acts-10:39.)
Rom-11: 16-24	K/V- 17.	<b>And if some of the branches were broken off, and you, being a wild olive tree, were grafted in among them</b> , and with them became a partaker of the root and fatness of the olive tree, (Heb-3:18-19.) (Heb-4:1-3.)
Gal-3: 10-14	K/V- 13.	Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us ( <b>for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"</b> ),
James-3: 10-17	K/V- 12.	<b>Can a fig tree, my brethren, bear olives, or a grapevine bear figs?</b> Thus no spring yields both salt water and fresh.
1-Pet-2: 20-25	K/V- 24.	<b>-who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree</b> , that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness--by whose stripes you were healed.
Rev-2: 7	K/V- 7.	He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. <b>To him who overcomes I will give to eat from the tree of life, which is in the midst of the Paradise of God.</b> ''
Rev-9: 4	K/V- 4.	They were commanded not to harm the grass of the earth, or any green thing, <b>or any tree</b> , but only those men who do not have the seal of God on their foreheads.
Rev-22: 1-4	K/V- 2.	In the middle of its street, and on either side of the river, <b>was the tree of life, which bore twelve fruits, each tree yielding its fruit every month. The leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations.</b>
