

Unrighteous Mammon

Matt-9: 10-13	K/V- 13.	But go and learn what this means: 'I desire mercy and not sacrifice.' For I did not come to call the righteous, but sinners, to repentance. " (Mk-2:15-17.) (Lk-5:30-32.)
Matt 11: 16-19	K.V- 19.	The Son of Man came eating and drinking, and they say, 'Look, a glutton and a winebibber, a friend of tax collectors and sinners!' But wisdom is justified by her children."
Luke 15: 1-10	K.V- 2.	And the Pharisees and scribes complained, saying, " This Man receives sinners and eats with them. "
Luke 16: 9-13	K.V- 9.	And I say to you, make friends for yourselves by unrighteous mammon, that when you fail, they may receive you into an everlasting home.
Rom 5: 1-9	K.V- 8.	But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
Rom-14: 1-4	K/V- 4.	Who are you to judge another's servant? To his own master he stands or falls. Indeed, he will be made to stand, for God is able to make him stand. (Matt-7:1-5.)
Rom-15: 1-3	K.V- 1.	We then who are strong ought to bear with the scruples of the weak, and not to please ourselves.
1-Cor-5: 1-13	K.V- 11.	But now I have written to you not to keep company with anyone named a brother, who is sexually immoral, or covetous, or an idolater, or a reviler, or a drunkard, or an extortioner--not even to eat with such a person.
1-Cor-6: 9-12	K/V- 11.	And such were some of you. But you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God. (Rom-3:23.)
1-Cor-9: 16-23	K.V- 22.	-to the weak I became as weak, that I might win the weak. I have become all things to all men, that I might by all means save some.
2-Cor-6: 14-18	K/V- 15.	(2-Cor-6:15.) 15. And what accord has Christ with Belial? Or what part has a believer with an unbeliever?
Gal-1: 6-9	K/V- 8.	(Gal-1:6-9.) 6. I marvel that you are turning away so soon from Him who called you in the grace of Christ, to a different gospel, 7. Which is not another; but there are some who trouble you and want to pervert the gospel of Christ. 8. But even if we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel to you than what we have preached to you, let him be accursed. 9. As we have said before, so now I say again, if anyone preaches any other gospel to you than what you have received, let him be accursed.
Gal-2: 11-21	K/V- 14.	But when I saw that they were not straightforward about the truth of the gospel, I said to Peter before them all, "If you, being a Jew, live in the manner of Gentiles and not as the Jews, why do you compel Gentiles to live as Jews?
1-Pet-3: 7-9	K/V- 7.	Husbands, likewise, dwelt with them with understanding, giving honor to the wife, as to the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life, that your prayers may not be hindered. (2-Cor-11:3-4.)
1-Jn-1: 7-10	K.V- 9.	If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
2-Jn-1: 9-11	K/V- 10.	9. Whoever transgresses and does not abide in the doctrine of Christ does not have God. He who abides in the doctrine of Christ has both the Father and the Son. 10. If anyone comes to you and does not bring this doctrine, do not receive him into your house nor greet him; 11. for he who greets him shares in his evil deeds.
