Matt-7: 13-20	K/V- 16.	You will know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes from thorn bushes or figs from thistles? (<u>Lk-6:44.</u>)
Matt-20: 1-16	K/V- 1.	"For the kingdom of heaven is like a landowner who went out early in the morning to hire laborers for his vineyard.
Matt-21: 28-32	K/V- 28.	"But what do you think? A man had two sons, and he came to the first and said, 'Son, go, work today in my vineyard.'
Matt-21: 33-44	K/V- 33.	"Hear another parable: There was a certain landowner who planted a vineyard and set a hedge around it, dug a winepress in it and built a tower. And he leased it to vinedressers and went into a far country. (<u>Mk-12:1-11.</u>)
Matt-26: 26-29	K/V- 29.	But I say to you, I will not drink of this fruit of the vine from now on until that day when I drink it new with you in My Father's kingdom. " (<u>Mk-14:25.</u>) (<u>Lk-22:18.</u>)
Luke-13: 6-9	K/V- 6.	He also spoke this parable: "A certain man had a fig tree planted in his vineyard, and he came seeking fruit on it and found none.
Luke-20: 9-18	K/V- 9.	Then He began to tell the people this parable: "A certain man planted a vineyard, leased it to vinedressers, and went into a far country for a long time.
John-15: 1-14	K/V- 1.	"I am the <u>true vine</u>, and My Father is the vinedresser.
1-Cor-9: 7-11	KV- 7.	Who ever goes to war at his own expense? Who plants a vineyard and does not eat of its fruit? Or who tends a flock and does not drink of the milk of the flock? (<u>1-Tim-5:18-20.</u>)
Rev-14: 18-20	K/V- 19.	So the angel thrust his sickle into the earth and gathered the vine of the earth, and threw it into the great winepress of the wrath of God.
