Job-32: 17-22	K/V- 19.	Indeed my belly is like wine that has no vent; It is ready to burst like new wineskins.
Psa-119: 83-84	K/V- 83.	For I have become like a wineskin in smoke, Yet I do not forget Your statutes.
Matt-9: 17	K/V- 17.	Nor do they put new wine into old wineskins, or else the wineskins break, the wine is spilled, and the wineskins are ruined. But they put new wine into new wineskins, and both are preserved." (Mk-2:22.) (Lk-5:37-38.)
Matt-11: 18-19	K/V- 19.	The Son of Man came eating and drinking, and they say, 'Look, a glutton and a winebibber, a friend of tax collectors and sinners!' But wisdom is justified by her children." (Lk-7:34.)
Matt-27: 34	K/V- 34.	-they gave Him sour wine mingled with gall to drink. But when He had tasted it, He would not drink. (Greek: Gall.) Bitter, Poisonous herb. Gall was frequently linked with wormwood. To denote bitterness and tragedy.
Matt-27: 47-49	K/V- 48.	Immediately one of them ran and took a sponge, filled it with sour wine and put it on a reed, and offered it to Him to drink.
Mark-15: 23	K/V- 23.	Then they gave Him wine mingled with myrrh to drink, but He did not take it.
Luke-1: 15	K/V- 15.	For he will be great in the sight of the Lord, and shall drink neither wine nor strong drink. He will also be filled with the Holy Spirit, even from his mother's womb.
Luke-5: 37-39	K/V- 39.	And no one, having drunk old wine, immediately desires new; for he says, 'The old is better.' "
Luke-7: 33-34	K/V- 33.	For John the Baptist came neither eating bread nor drinking wine, and you say, 'He has a demon.'
Luke-10: 30-37	K/V- 34.	So he went to him and bandaged his wounds, pouring on oil and wine ; and he set him on his own animal, brought him to an inn, and took care of him.
John-2: 1-10	K/V- 3.	And when they ran out of wine, the mother of Jesus said to Him, "They have no wine." (John-4:46.)
John-19: 28-30	K/V- 29.	Now a vessel full of sour wine was sitting there; and they filled a sponge with sour wine, put it on hyssop, and put it to His mouth.
Acts-2: 13-23	K/V- 13.	Others mocking said, "They are full of new wine." (Joel-2:28-32.)
Rom-14: 16-23	K/V- 21.	It is good neither to eat meat nor drink wine nor do anything by which your brother stumbles or is offended or is made weak.
Eph-5: 17-21	K/V- 18.	And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit,
1-Tim-3: 3-8	K/V- 3.	-not given to wine, not violent, not greedy for money, but gentle, not quarrelsome, not covetous; (Titus-1:7.)
1-Tim-5: 22-25	K/V- 23.	No longer drink only water, but use a little wine for your stomach's sake and your frequent infirmities.
Titus-2: 3-5	K/V- 3.	-the older women likewise, that they be reverent in behavior, not slanderers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things
Rev-6: 5-6	K/V- 6.	And I heard a voice in the midst of the four living creatures saying, "A quart of wheat for a denarius, and three quarts of barley for a denarius; and do not harm the oil and the wine."

Rev-14:	K/V- 8.	And another angel followed, saying, "Babylon is fallen, is fallen, that great city, because

Rev-14:	K/V- 10.	-he himself shall also drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out full
