They profess that they know God; but in works they deny him, being abominable, and disobedient, and unto every good work reprobate.
Titus-2:6-8	K/V-7	6. Young men likewise exhort to be sober minded. 7. In all things shewing thyself a pattern of good works: in doctrine shewing uncorruptness, gravity, sincerity, 8. Sound speech, that cannot be condemned; that he that is of the contrary part may be ashamed, having no evil thing to say of you.
Titus-2:11-15	K/V-14	11. For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men, 12. Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world; 13. Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ; 14. Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works. 15. These things speak, and exhort, and rebuke with all authority. Let no man despise thee.
Titus-3:1-9	K/V-1	1. Put them in mind to be subject to principalities and powers, to obey magistrates, to be ready to every good work, 2. To speak evil of no man, to be no brawlers, but gentle, shewing all meekness unto all men.3. For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful, and hating one another. 4. But after that the kindness and love of God our Saviour toward man appeared, 5. Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost; 6. Which he shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Saviour; 7. That being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life. 8. This is a faithful saying, and these things I will that thou affirm constantly, that they which have believed in God might be careful to maintain good works. These things are good and profitable unto men. 9. But avoid foolish questions, and genealogies, and contentions, and strivings about the law; for they are unprofitable and vain.

Not the works of the Law

Romans-3:27-28	K/V-27	27. Where is boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? of works? Nay:
		but by the law of faith. 28. Therefore we conclude that a man is
		justified by faith without the deeds of the law.
Romans-9:31-33	K/V-32	31 . But Israel, which followed after the law of righteousness, hath not
		attained to the law of righteousness. 32. Wherefore? Because they
		sought it not by faith, but as it were by the works of the law. For they
		stumbled at that stumblingstone; 33 . As it is written, Behold, I lay in
		Sion a stumblingstone and rock of offence: and whosoever believeth on
		him shall not be ashamed.
Galatians-2:16-17	K/V-16	16. Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but
		by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that
		we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the
		law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified. 17. But if,
		while we seek to be justified by Christ, we ourselves also are found
		sinners, is therefore Christ the minister of sin? God forbid.
