Matt-11: 28-30	K/V- 29. K/V- 30.	^{29.} Take <u>My yoke</u> upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. ^{30.} For <u>My yoke is easy</u> and My burden is <u>light.</u> (<u>Rom-13:14.</u>) But put on the Lord Jesus Christ , and make no provision for the flesh, to fulfill its lusts.
John-14: 6-12	K/V- 6.	Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me. (<u>Jn-8:31-32.</u> ^{32.}) And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." (<u>Jn-8:36.</u>) Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed.
Acts-15: 1-11	K/V- 10.	Now therefore, why do you test God by putting a yoke on the neck of the disciples which neither our fathers nor we were able to bear? (<u>Matt-23:1-7.</u> ^{4.}) For they bind heavy burdens , hard to bear, and lay them on men's shoulders ; but they themselves will not move them with one of their fingers.
1-Tim-6: 1-5	K/V- 1.	Let as many bondservants as are under the yoke count their own masters worthy of all honour , so that the name of God and His doctrine may not be blasphemed.
